The District 2 team and I are focused on protecting our communities by taking deliberate actions to - preserve the environmental assets, encourage business recovery, support the resiliency of the arts and providing COVID-19 vaccination incentives. We also celebrated a few of our Arts Grant recipients with check presentations to inform them of resources coming their way. 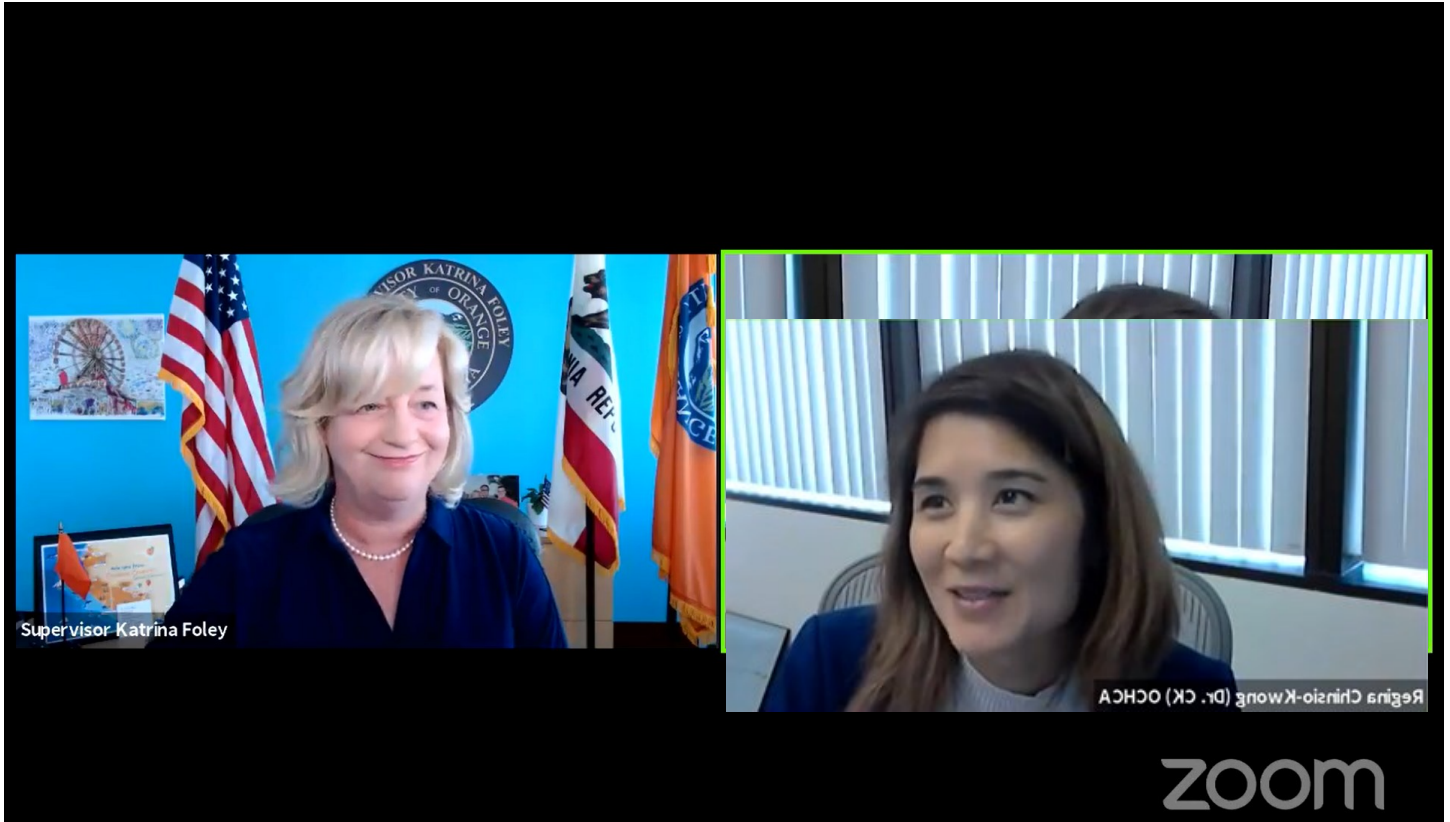
Our priority continues to focus on COVID-19 vaccinations within Orange County. Beginning the week of September 13th, our office has offered gift card incentives to residents coming to our vaccination sites. As of today, we have provided more than 150 gift cards valued at \$25 each in vaccine incentives equating to more than 150 additional "shots in arms". As of September 23, 2021, District 2 has reached approximately a 65% fully vaccinated rate.

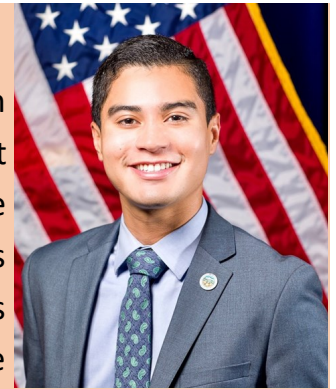


DISTRICT 2 COMMUNITY UPDATES

County of Orange Offers Public Workshop on County's Strategic Financial Plan, Budget Development Processes, American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funding

Santa Ana, Calif. (September 24, 2021) – The County's Budget Office will hold a public workshop at 1:30 pm on Thursday, September 30, 2021 in the Board of Supervisors Hearing and Planning Commission Rooms to educate the public on the County's strategic financial planning and budget development processes and use of the ARPA funds. Members of the public may submit comments now through October 22, 2021 on use of the ARPA funds as part of the County's planning process by going to the comment form found [here](#).

For those wishing to participate virtually, they may view it online by clicking [here](#). For those wishing to call in to ask questions, they may do so by calling 877-226-8189, access code: 8672103. Translation services will be provided in Chinese, Korean, Spanish, and Vietnamese upon request made 72 hours in advance of the workshop by emailing CEOCOM@ocgov.com.

Orange County residents may also view more information on the County's [ARPA and CARES Act Transparency website](#) for constituents.

The website includes expenditure information related to both Acts, an overview of the ARPA funding and the 2021 Performance Plan and links to the US Treasury ARPA website. The ARPA information will be updated periodically as new information becomes available. The website also includes the final reporting on the County's use of CARES Act funds.

In addition, the County kicked off its annual strategic financial planning process on August 16, 2021. The 2021 Strategic Financial Plan will be presented to the Board of Supervisors on December 14, 2021. This year's strategic financial planning process will include the County's plan and CEO recommendations on the use of the ARPA funds. The County of Orange received 50 percent of its \$617 million federal allocation on May 21, 2021 and will receive the remaining funds no earlier than 12 months from May 21, 2021. CALIFORNIA SMALL BUSINESS COVID-19 RELIEF GRANT PROGRAM



A round of new funding has opened up with a final submission DEADLINE SEPTEMBER 30 for California's Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant Program. The program provides grants of **\$5,000 to \$25,000** to small businesses hurt by the pandemic. Businesses are eligible based on annual revenue as documented in their most recent tax return. Until September 8, the program is processing waitlisted applicants from previous rounds. Waitlisted applicants do not need to reapply.

This week, the Second District hosted a Virtual Small Business Roundtable. This session focused on Rounds 8 and 9 of the California Small Business Covid-19 Relief Grant Program. This program is funded by the State of California and Administered by CalOSBA. Grants are being awarded between \$5,000-25,000 to companies with annual revenue of up to \$2,500,000 annually. This week's roundtable was hosted by Patricia Click from The Center by Lendistry. The Center by Lendistry has helped secure \$7.3 billion in small business grants and loans. We appreciate Ms. Click's expertise in helping the residents of District 2 secure funding. **However, time is running out as the last day to submit applications for the program will be on September 30, 2021.**

The successful candidate will be responsible for assisting with bridging the relationship between the cities, school and special districts, as well as state and federal delegation offices, chambers of commerce and community organizations, and the Supervisor's office. The ideal candidate is a self-starter with excellent oral communication and relationship building skills. The individual should have established relationships in the communities they serve as well as an understanding and passion for women policy issues and senior citizen advocacy. The successful candidate must have the ability to deliver error-free, high quality work under tight deadlines.

DAY-TO-DAY RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Working with cities, businesses, and residents to help address concerns and opportunities
- Staffing the Supervisor at events and setting up community pop-ups, tables, tents to represent the Second District effectively
- Providing updates at city council meetings, chamber meetings, school and special district meetings, and internal staff meetings regarding progress on the Supervisor's 6 key priorities; and conveying the needs of the District back to the community.
- Preparing briefing memos, scheduling request forms, error-free certificates and completing special projects as assigned
- Maintaining team tracking spreadsheets and fielding constituent calls in the office
- Assisting with developing content for the newsletter, social media, and website
- Determining creative ways to expand the Supervisor's coverage and services to the Second District

QUALIFICATIONS

- Orange County ties, specifically in Huntington Beach and Newport Beach is a requirement
- BA in a related field (e.g., Political Science, Public Policy, English, Communications, or a related field), or equivalent work experience

OVERVIEW

The Youth Ride Free program is a promotional pass that allows youth 18 and under to ride all OC Bus fixed-route buses for free. The six-month program will start in September 2021 and passes will be valid through February 28, 2022.

Passes and marketing information will be distributed in partnership with Orange County schools, with parents able to request a pass from participating schools, the OCTA store, or at [OCbus.com/YouthRideFree](https://ocbus.com/YouthRideFree).

BENEFITS

- Offers a promotional free fare for youth 18 and under, providing a reliable transportation option for education, work, and leisure.
- Promotional free pass valid on any OC Bus fixed-route service, including weekends and holidays.
- Supports the economic recovery of Orange County and helps mitigate the financial impacts from the COVID-19 pandemic on low income and diverse populations.
- Allows youth from all over Orange County to equitably re-engage with education and other opportunities following pandemic restrictions.
- Helps introduce new youth riders to public transit, encouraging long term usage.
- Improves mobility options, reduce congestion, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.
- Provides rider feedback and information for future youth program development.

FUNDING

This Youth Free Fare promotion is grant-funded by the Low Carbon Transit Operations Program through California Climate Investments, a statewide initiative that puts billions of Cap-and-Trade dollars to work reducing greenhouse gas emissions, strengthening the economy, and improving public health and the environment – particularly in disadvantaged communities.
