Dear Mr. Barthold:

We would like to request a revenue estimate of H.R. 2934, which clarifies authority for public agencies to allow Orange County and other local jurisdictions to propose and implement a hybrid pension system. In Orange County, most county employees contribute up to 15% of their paychecks to pay for their pensions. A hybrid plan would increase the take-home pay for current and new employees and it would give the county an opportunity to get a better handle on its growing unfunded liability problem. H.R. 2934 is a bipartisan bill that is supported by the County of Orange, Orange County Employees Association and other municipalities and labor organizations state and nationwide. Additionally, a Wall Street Journal commentary holds the hybrid plan as a shining example to other local and state governments on how to begin navigating their way out of the public pension disaster.
