Robert R. (Randy) Redwitz CPA, and President Robert R. Redwitz & Co.

A graduate of St. Catherine of Siena elementary school in Laguna Beach in 1960 and Servite High School in Anaheim in 1964, Randy attended St. John's Seminary College in Camarillo graduating in 1968 with a Bachelor of Arts degree with a major in Philosophy and a minor in English. In 1973 Randy received a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Southern California with a major in Accounting.

In 1973 he received his license to practice as a Certified Public Accountant. At the same time Randy became a member of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants and the California Society of CPA's. From 1970 to 1975 Randy held multiple positions within two CPA firms in the southern California area.

In 1975 he formed Robert R. Redwitz & Co., an Accounting and Consulting Corporation with a heavy emphasis in audit, business taxation, outsourced CFO services for a variety of industries including non-profit entities. Fulfilling a desire to provide a broad set of business solutions to his CPA firm business clients and other non-CPA firm business clients, Randy and two additional individuals formed in 1997 The GDR Group, Inc. to specialize in information technology system installations, hardware, software and managed support. Randy and one additional individual formed The Diamond Group to specialize in business to government relations consulting. Further, in 2003 he formed Redwitz Wealth Management Group, Inc. specializing in personal financial planning and financial asset management. Finally in 2006 Randy and one other individual formed Learning Communications, LLC specializing in human resource training and training support educational products. Collectively the five companies are known as Redwitz Business Solutions. The Orange County Business Journal has ranked Redwitz Business Solutions number 8 among the top 40 CPA firms in Orange County.

Within his companies and individually Randy has worked very closely with our Diocese of Orange over the last 20 plus years. From 1989 to 2010 Randy served as the Business Manager for Santa Margarita Catholic High School and overseer of the development of the Master Plan for SMCHS. Randy still serves as a financial consultant to SMCHS to this day. From 1992 to 2010 Randy served on the Diocesan Consultative School Board and for most of those years was the Board's Chairperson. For the last 22 years Randy has served on the Finance Commission of St. Edward's Catholic Church and for the last 12 years served as its Chairperson.

Married to his wife Claudia for 42 years, Randy and Claudia have lived in San Juan Capistrano for the past 31 years where they raised their 5 children. They are both active members in their St. Edward the Confessor parish community and the surrounding civic communities. Randy and Claudia are both members of the Orange Coast Chapter of Legatus. Randy is a vested knight in the Order of Malta and Claudia is a vested dame in the Order of Malta. Randy serves as the chief financial officer of the Orange County location of the Order of Malta.



Frank P. Kavanaugh Fort Ashford Holdings, LLC

Frank Kavanaugh specializes in restructuring and recapitalizing emerging and troubled companies and transforming them into highly productive and leading edge businesses.

As one of the managing partners at Fort Ashford Holdings, LLC, he leads the investment process and

serves as a director at several portfolio companies, including Jet-Hot High Performance Coatings.

From 2001 through 2007 he established Force Protection, Inc. (FRPT), now a division of General Dynamics, and served as the Chairman of the company until he retired in June 2007. Under his leadership, Force Protection's revenue grew from less than \$1 million to over \$1 billion. He co-founded and served as President/CEO of QuickStart Technologies and previously held positions at Microsoft and Hewlett Packard.

Daniel K. Walker, Chairman of the Board Farmers & Merchants Bank

Bruno Serato Restaurant Proprietor CNN 2011 Hero

When Bruno Serato came to America three decades ago, he had \$200 in his pocket, virtually no knowledge of the English language, and made a living by washing dishes in a restaurant. His is the quintessential American success story; not simply for his success in owning one of Orange County's most highly regarded restaurants, but for his inspiring dedication to serving the community.

Bruno purchased the famous Anaheim White House Restaurant in 1987, which he has used to serve award-winning cuisine and utilize as a platform to serve the community, both figuratively and literally.

In 2005, Bruno and his mother, Caterina, visited the Boys and Girls Club of Anaheim, where his mother noticed that there was a 6-year old boy eating potato chips for dinner, because his family couldn't afford a proper meal. Caterina insisted that Bruno make some pasta for the child. They soon realized that there were many more of these hungry 'motel children', so Bruno began making pasta for 72 children, 5 nights a week. Today, that event has now expanded to feeding nearly 300 kids, 7 nights a week and over a quarter of a million meals to date.

In homage to his own humble beginnings, Bruno has made it a priority to give back to those less fortunate in the community. This year alone Bruno Serato donated over 250 charity luncheon giveaways to local organizations valuing over 1 million dollars. This luncheon allows each non profit selected to host a free luncheon to help raise money for their organization without the cost of the event.

Bruno has been selected as the 2012 Americana Man of the Year by the Cypress College Foundation and in 2011 was named a Hometown Hero by PEOPLE Magazine. Most recently Bruno was recognized as a Top 10 2011 CNN Hero. Bruno received this distinction internationally televised CNN Heroes: An All Star Tribute hosted by Anderson Cooper and was introduced by Jerry Seinfeld.

Keynote Speakers



Gregory J. Boyle, S.J. Founder and Chief Executive Officer – Homeboy Industries

Fr. Gregory Boyle – best known as Fr. Greg by all who meet him -- was born in Los Angeles, one of eight children. After graduating from Loyola High School in Los Angeles in 1972, he entered the order of the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) and was ordained a priest in 1984.

He received his BA in English from Gonzaga University; an MA in English from Loyola

Marymount University; a Master of Divinity from the Weston School of Theology; and a Sacred Theology Masters degree from the Jesuit School of Theology. The year 2009 was the 25th anniversary of Father Greg's ordination as a priest.

Homeboy Industries traces its roots to "Jobs For A Future" (JFF), a program created in 1988 by Fr. Greg at Dolores Mission parish. In an effort to address the escalating problems and unmet needs of gang-involved youth, Fr. Greg and the community developed positive alternatives, including establishing an elementary school, a day care program and finding legitimate employment for young people. JFF's success demonstrated the model followed today that many gang members are eager to leave the dangerous and destructive life on the "streets."

As Executive Director of Homeboy Industries and an acknowledged expert on gangs and intervention approaches, Fr. Boyle is a nationally renowned speaker. He has given commencement addresses at numerous universities, as well as spoken at conferences for teachers, social workers, criminal justice workers and others about the importance of adult attention, guidance and unconditional love in preventing youth from joining gangs. Fr. Greg and several "homies" were featured speakers at the White House Conference on Youth in 2005 at the personal invitation of Mrs. George Bush.

In 2009 the Los Angeles Headquarters Association honored Fr. Greg as one of the city's leading visionaries responsible for changing the face of Los Angeles, and the Harvard Club of Southern California recognized him with the John Harvard Award for Distinguished Service to the Community. In celebration of the 25th Anniversary of his ordination, an acknowledgement of his tireless service was read into the Congressional Record by Representative Lucille

Roybal-Allard (D-CA). The Elfenworks Foundation presented the In Harmony with Hope Award to Fr. Greg and Homeboy, and the Los Angeles Chapter of the Public Relations Society of America named Fr. Greg as 2009 Citizen of the Year. The Bank of America Charitable Foundation selected Fr. Greg and Homeboy Industries as a recipient of the 2009 Neighborhood Excellence Initiative Builder award, acknowledging our work in job training.

Father Greg's first book, *Tattoos on the Heart*: The Power of Boundless Compassion, was released on March 9, 2010, which received the 2010 SCIBA (Southern California Indie Booksellers Association) Non-Fiction Book Award and was named as one of the Best Books of 2010 by Publishers Weekly.




Ken Blanchard Chief Spiritual Officer of The Ken Blanchard Companies Author of "The One Minute Manager"

Ken Blanchard has had an extraordinary impact on the day-to-day management of millions of people and companies. He is the author of several bestselling books, including the blockbuster international bestseller *The One Minute Manager** and the giant business bestsellers *Leadership and the One Minute Manager*, *Raving Fans, and Gung Ho!*. His books have combined sales of nearly 20 million copies in more than twenty-seven languages. In 2005 Ken was inducted into Amazon's Hall of Fame as one of the top 25 bestselling authors of all time.

Ken is the chief spiritual officer of The Ken Blanchard Companies, an international management training and consulting firm. He is also cofounder of the Lead Like Jesus Ministries. The College of Business at Grand Canyon University bears his name.

Ken and his wife, Margie, live in San Diego, California.

Reverend Monsignor Lawrence J. Baird, P.A.

A native of Ontario, Canada, Monsignor Baird attended elementary and high schools before he immigrated to California with his parents, Mary and Wilfred, and his three siblings in 1961.

He studied for the Catholic priesthood at St. John's College and St. John's Seminary in Camarillo where he earned a Bachelor's

degree in Philosophy in 1965. Ordained to the priesthood in 1969, he earned a Master of Arts degree in Theology at the Graduate Theological Union, Berkeley University, in 1981.

He served as an Associate Pastor at St. John Vianney parish, Hacienda Heights, and St. Anthony Claret parish, Anaheim. He was Pastor of St. Callistus, Garden Grove, and St. Polycarp parish in Stanton.

Monsignor Baird has served in many administrative capacities in the Diocese of Orange including Ecumenical Officer, Director of Youth Ministries, Director of Marywood Center, Director of Office of Development, Director of Communications, Editor of Diocese of Orange Bulletin, Chaplain of the Catholic Alumni Club and Catholic Spirit. He is currently a member of the Diocesan Finance Council and the Board of Directors of the Orange Catholic Foundation.

He has been involved in the Orange County community in many volunteer roles since 1977 including National Conference of Christians and Jews, Concern of Orange, Board of Directors of United Way, Board of Directors of St. Michael's Abbey Foundation, Board of Directors of Patrons of the Arts in the Vatican Museums, and Chaplain of Legatus.
