R. Lynn Livingston (1940 – 2008)

Colleagues, I ask that we adjourn today's meeting in memory of Lynn Livingston, who passed away on November 25, 2008 at age 68 in the City of Orange.

Lynn was born in Beloit, Wisconsin and moved along with his family to California in 1951. Lynn was a graduate of the University of Southern California and a Navy veteran, who served in Vietnam and as an aide to the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff.

After leaving the Navy, Lynn went on to be an influential and trail blazing advertising and marketing executive for over 45 years. He was President and Chief Executive Officer of Cochrane Chase, Livingston which was one of the best known independent advertising agencies during the 1980's.

Cochrane Chase, Livingston created many award winning campaigns for such clients as Carl's Jr. Restaurants, Pirelli Tires and Blue Cross of California. Lynn was recognized by his colleagues and peers as one of the most knowledgeable and well regarded men in the advertising and marketing industries.

Lynn is survived by his former wife and dear friend Patricia, three children, and three grandchildren. He is also survived by his sister, Sandy, and brother, Jeff, and their families.
