As Orange County's pediatric healthcare leader, CHOC is currently growing to better serve the needs of the community's children and families, including the new 30-bed Pediatric/Cardiovascular Intensive Care Unit (PICU), current expansion of the Ambulatory Care Center, continuous implementation of new technology, and innovative patient and safety initiatives, which have prompted CHOC's inclusion on the Leapfrog "Top Hospital's 2007" list.

CHOC will be honored along with other CAPE Award recipients at the CCE's 14th Annual Conference & Awards Ceremony to be held on Friday, March 28, 2008, at the Renaissance Hotel in Long Beach. CHOC has been invited to make a presentation on the hospital's journey and best practices at the conference.
