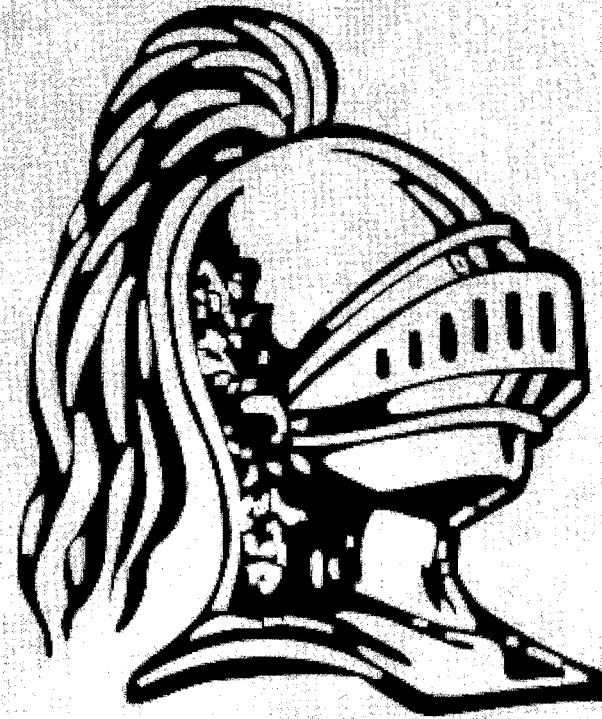


Foothill High School Science Center Facts and Figures

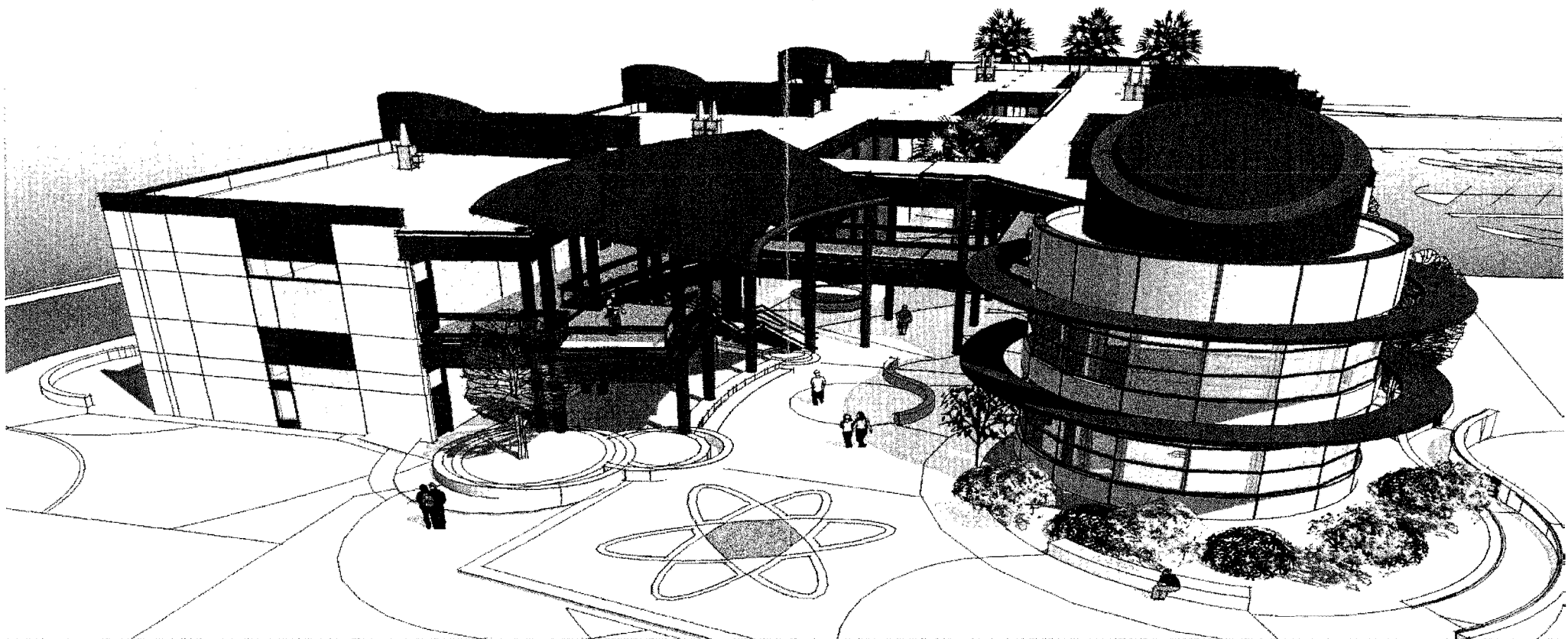
- Size: 48,000 square feet
- Two-story building featuring 14 classrooms: five Biology labs, four Chemistry labs, two Earth Science classrooms, two multi-use classrooms and a Physics lab
- Other features: staff office and conference room, rest rooms, storage rooms and elevator
- Special design elements including: curved prep rooms, curved glass-block stairway enclosure and curved tall shade structure
- Outside area: landscaped courtyard with curved planters that double as seating areas
- Designer: NTD Architecture
- Builder: Barnhart-Heery
- Cost: \$19 million
- Funding: Measure G Modernization Program
