Colleagues, I would like to adjourn today's meeting in memory of Kenneth Stewart Morgan, a resident of Orange who worked 28 ½ years for the County of Orange.

Ken Morgan grew up in Orange County. He graduated from Bolsa Grande High School in Garden Grove and went on to achieve a degree of Bachelors of Business Administration and a minor in Accounting from Cal State Long Beach and work for several years in the private sector.

Ken was hired by the Auditor-Controller's Office in 1980 to work on the accounting team for HCA-Mental Health. After 7 years, ken was promoted to Social Services Agency where he worked for another 19 years as a lead budget manager and in various administrative positions.

Ken's last two years of service were spent as the administrative officer for the OC Watersheds Program. Throughout his career, Ken proved himself to be a highly productive and valued member of the County team.

Ken enjoyed life and people around him and was a devout Christian. He enjoyed playing the guitar and in his teen years played in a couple of rock bands.

After 28 ½ years of County service Ken retired on October 23, 2008 to devote more time to music, travel, and family. At the end of December, Ken was diagnosed with liver cancer and went home to the Lord on June 25, 2009.

He is survived by his father Dodson, brother, Ron, and sister-in-law, Davene (pronounced da-VEEN).
