MISSION VIEJO


- 1964 County approves Mission Viejo community plan
- Plan to include
 - Schools
 - Parks
 - Community facilities
- Unique features
 - Thematic landscape
 - Architecture
 - Cul-de-sacs
 - Roundabouts,
 - Community centers
 - Mission Viejo lake
- 1988 City becomes 27th city in County of Orange
- Approx. 100,000 people today





RANCHO SANTA MARGARITA

- 1986 Ranch family joins with County of Orange to begin planning
- New Community Design All in one place
 - Homes
 - Recreational amenities
 - Employment
- Balanced Community
 - Increased sensitivity to open space
 - Preserved ridgelines
 - High housing density
 - Town centers
- 2000 City becomes 33rd city in the County of Orange
- Approx. 47,000 people today.

- Over 15,000 people today
















VILLAGE OF SENDERO


