



Armory Emergency Shelter Program 2014 - 2015

PROGRAM SUMMARY:

The Orange County Armory Emergency Shelter program provides up to 400 beds per night for the homeless at the National Guard Armories in Fullerton and Santa Ana. The homeless will receive a nutritious meal, a warm shower and a safe place to sleep. Volunteers will pass out donations of warm clothing and service providers from Orange County will be onsite to provide needed services.

DATES: The armories will open at the following alternate locations:

Friday, November 14 - EV Free Church (Gym), Fullerton

Saturday, November 15 - EV Free Church (Gym), Fullerton

Sunday, November 16 - Independence Park (Gym), Fullerton

Monday, November 17 – Shelters open at both Armories
