The Orange County Local Agency Formation Commission (OC LAFCO) is a state agency charged with encouraging logical agency boundaries and the efficient delivery of municipal services. OC LAFCO has received applications from the East Orange County Water District and the Irvine Ranch Water District for LAFCO approval of actions that would allow either District to assume local sewer service in the western portion of the City of Tustin, unincorporated North Tustin (including Cowan Heights, Lemon Heights, Panorama Heights, Red Hill and Rocking Horse Ridge) as well as the unincorporated community known as El Modena, which is adjacent to the City of Orange. Local sewer service is currently provided by the Orange County Sanitation District which also provides regional sewage collection and treatment to much of north and central Orange County.
