Orange County (OC) Public Works invites you to learn about important road improvements on **Trabuco Canyon Road** and **Live Oak Canyon Road** (please see map also on opposite side).

Safety enhancements will include installing a high friction pavement surface, replacing guardrail, installing rumble strips along the centerline of the roadway, upgrading signage and widening shoulders where feasible. Work is anticipated to begin as early as **mid-February 2017** (schedule is tentative and could change due to weather or other factors).

These road improvements are anticipated to occur over a period of four (4) months.

This will require a **partial road closure and intermittent full road closure** in some areas for drivers along Trabuco Canyon Road and Live Oak Canyon Road. We will make every effort to minimize any inconvenience as we strive to complete these safety enhancements as quickly and safely as possible.

Trabuco Canyon Road:

From O'Neill Regional Park entrance to the Rancho Santa Margarita city limit (*approx. 1.41 miles*), and;

Live Oak Canyon Road:

From the intersection of El Toro Road / Santiago Canyon Road to O'Neill Regional Park Entrance (*approx. 3.31 miles*)
