18th Annual Villa Park Dry Land Boat Parade Sunday, December 13th

Vessels will begin their tour of our VP asphalt harbor beginning at 5:00 PM on Taft Avenue by VPHS and end their parade journey in the VP Towne Centre (by Wayne's Liquor) about 6:30 PM.

Celebrating will continue with a tree lighting ceremony, great music, food and merchandise vendors plus awarding of trophies for uniquely decorated crafts in front of VP City Hall. **Fun for everyone!**

Create some life-time memories for your family or those in your organization by entering a decorated boat...which may be defined as “anything that can be towed or driven at a speed of up to five miles an hour.” Trees and other obstacles along the Dry Land Parade route will necessarily limit the height of entries to 15 feet and the width to 10 feet. However, the amount of imagination and creativity used in conceiving and subsequently decorating each entry should only be limited by common sense and tastefulness. **Go for it!**

Roll on over to VP City Hall to get your parade entry form. Return form to VP City Hall by 12/11 with entry fee to obtain a number and be eligible to win a trophy.
