

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF ORANGE IN SUPPORT  
OF THE LOS ANGELES STADIUM IN THE CITY OF  
INDUSTRY**

*September 13, 2011*

**WHEREAS**, *our region has been without a professional football team for over a decade; and*

**WHEREAS**, *the Los Angeles Stadium in the City of Industry is being considered for a potential new professional football team; that professional football is a known major stimulus to a regional economy because of the direct and indirect jobs associated with it and the facilities developed to support it; and*

**WHEREAS**, *the project known as the Los Angeles Stadium in the City of Industry has all environmental approvals, has secured its development approvals and is ready for construction (shovel ready); and*

**WHEREAS**, *the Los Angeles Football Stadium in the City of Industry is being financed solely through private funds and without any public money; and*

**WHEREAS**, *the Los Angeles Football Stadium in the City of Industry is projected to generate 18,000 regional jobs that could provide employment to Orange County residents and hundreds of millions of dollars in economic benefit for the entire region; and*

**WHEREAS**, *the Los Angeles Football Stadium in the City of Industry is located at a central location in Southern California that is easily accessible to fans of Orange County; that the majority of NFL stadiums are outside the immediate urban core of the cities they represent; that Orange County has a flourishing business community and a strong population base that should be considered by the NFL; and*

**WHEREAS**, *the Los Angeles Football Stadium in the City of Industry is the only NFL stadium proposed that offers significant economic benefit to Orange County;*

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS** *hereby endorses the Los Angeles Football Stadium in the City of Industry and asserts that this stadium will provide the best location and venue for professional football for Orange County residents.*
