

HomeAid Orange County's 4th Annual **Essentials for Young Lives Campaign**

In partnership with the Children and Families Commission of Orange County

Essentials for Young Lives is a community-wide effort lead by HomeAid Orange County, in partnership with the Children and Families Commission of Orange County, to collect much needed items for homeless infants and toddlers across Orange County. These "Essentials" include: diapers, baby food, wipes and other hygiene products.

The 2010 Essentials for Young Lives Campaign across Orange County collected more than 273,000 baby items, an 88% increase over 2009 totals. This year, our goal is to collect more than one-half million baby items.

WHY?

Families are the fastest growing segment of the homeless population. Essentials for Young Lives donations enable recipient agencies to save the funds normally spent on diapers, baby wipes, etc. for use on programs to help their clients achieve self-sufficiency and to lead productive, independent lives.

WHY MAY?

During the December holiday season, most non-profit organizations receive bountiful contributions and due to demand, often they've depleted their resources by mid-year. Feedback from recipient agencies confirms the scheduling of May, in connection with Mother's Day, collections came when their supplies were low or non-existent.

WHO RECEIVES DONATIONS?

Donations are divided among HomeAid's sixteen service provider partners. These are the agencies that operate facilities built in partnership with HomeAid Orange County and serve homeless families across the county.
