- 3. The rights and responsibilities of bicyclists under the California Vehicle Code;
- 4. Bicyclist needs and expectations as users of transportation facilities;
- 5. Safety, mobility and access issues; bicyclist travel behaviors that maximize safety and mobility;
- 6. Maintaining bicyclist safety, mobility and access through work zones.
- 7. Applying transportation planning, traffic operations, and design "best practices" to maximize bicyclist safety and mobility, and support California's "Complete Streets" policy.

By the end of the workshop, attendees are able to more fully understand and apply guidance found in the Highway Design Manual, Project Development Procedures Manual, California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, and better implement your city's "Complete Streets" policy.
