



Caltrans Construction Notice

Interstate 5 FULL FREEWAY Closure

Alondra Boulevard Bridge Project

WHAT

The northbound and southbound Santa Ana Freeway (I-5), between Valley View Avenue and Carmenita Road in the cities of La Mirada and Santa Fe Springs, will **FULLY CLOSE** overnight for four hours to place k-rail (concrete barriers) in the center median and to re-stripe the lanes. The work is part of the I-5 South Corridor Improvement Projects from the Los Angeles/Orange County line to the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605).

WHERE

Northbound and southbound I-5 between Valley View Avenue and Carmenita Road. See the detour map below. Detours will be signed.

WHEN

(1 night) Overnight

- Wednesday, April 11 from 11:59 p.m. to 4 a.m.

(4 nights) Overnight

- Monday, April 16 through Thursday, April 19 from 11:59 p.m. to 4 a.m.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists will not have access to northbound and southbound I-5 freeway lanes between Valley View Avenue and Carmenita Road. Motorists will be detoured off the freeway system at Valley View off-ramp on the northbound direction and at Carmenita Road off-ramp on the southbound direction.

Crews and equipment will be working in the center median. Please Slow for the Cone Zone and consider the detour in your commute times.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Caltrans is constructing one carpool lane and one general purpose lane in each direction, reconstructing the Alondra Boulevard and the North Fork Coyote Creek overcrossings. Adjacent frontage roads will be realigned and upgraded to improve traffic flow.
