- ➤ In 2011 AccessCal served 6,056 unduplicated clients
- AccessCal administered approximately 13,500 units of service
- > 51% of our clients are Arab; 17% South Asian; 18% Hispanic; 7% African-American; and 7% Other
- > 55% of the clients we served are women
- 85% of our clients in 2011 were classified as low and extremely low-income according to the Federal Income Guidelines (FIG)
- AccessCal provided employment services 200 unemployed individuals
- We helped approximately 1,000 individuals, families, and pregnant women obtain health insurance
