



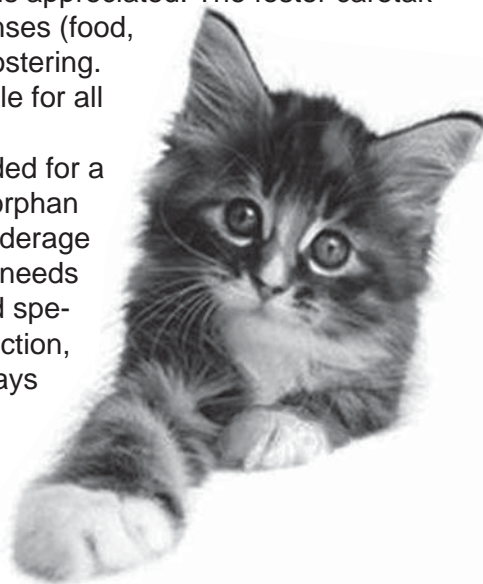
**A** foster caretaker provides a temporary home for young, injured, abused or under-socialized animals. Foster caretakers care for and return these animals when they are deemed suitable for adoption. The foster caretaker has the first opportunity to adopt the animal at regular adoption fees.

Generally, a foster animal stays with the foster caretaker for two to four weeks. Flexibility is appreciated. The foster caretaker is responsible for all expenses (food, shelter, etc.) incurred while fostering. OC Animal Care is responsible for all medical care.

Foster caretakers are needed for a variety of reasons including orphan kittens under two pounds, underage orphan puppies, and special needs animals. These animals need special attention and extra interaction, which the shelter cannot always provide.

OC Animal Care is always seeking additional foster caretakers who are looking for a challenging and rewarding experience. By opening your heart and your home, you are giving these animals a second chance.

- Foster Caretaker Requirements:**
- Must complete volunteer paperwork**
  - Must sign Foster Caretaker agreement**
  - Must have experience with animals**
  - Must be able to provide a safe, stable, and loving environment**
  - Must be able to transport foster animals to and from the shelter**
  - Must provide food, shelter, socialization, and any other needs of specific animals**
  - Must have patience to deal with animal illness or occasional death due to complications that can arise**
  - Must be 18 years or older**
