AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ORANGE, CALIFORNIA,
PROHIBITING THE INSTALLATION OF AUTOMATED "RED LIGHT"
TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT CAMERAS IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS
CREATING ARTICLE 8 OF DIVISION 1 OF TITLE 6 AND ADDING
SECTION 6-1-140 TO ARTICLE 8 OF DIVISION 1 OF
TITLE 6, TO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
OF THE COUNTY OF ORANGE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Orange, California, ordains as follows:


SECTION 1: Article 8 of Division 1 of Title 6 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Orange is hereby created entitled "Miscellaneous."

SECTION 2: Section 6-1-140 is added to Article 8 of Division 1 of Title 6 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Orange to read:

Section 6-1-140. Prohibition on Installation of Automated Traffic Enforcement Systems.

Automated traffic enforcement systems, as the term is used in California Vehicle Code Section 21455.5, as it now exists or hereinafter may be amended or re-worded, shall not be installed within any locations in unincorporated Orange County, used for any purpose on a County street or highway that is within the jurisdiction of the County of Orange, or used for any purpose related to traffic enforcement within the unincorporated areas of Orange County.
