Who should attend?

Families and friends affected by the mysterious disappearance of a loved one.

What will the day include?

One on one meetings with forensic professionals who will be collecting dental records, medical reports and photographs of missing persons, and performing DNA cheek swabs on family members. Law enforcement will be on hand to file missing person reports, and gather and update information on older reports.

What to bring?

Families are encouraged to bring at least two biologically related family members of the missing person in order to provide DNA samples and any dental information, photographs and X-rays of the missing person.
