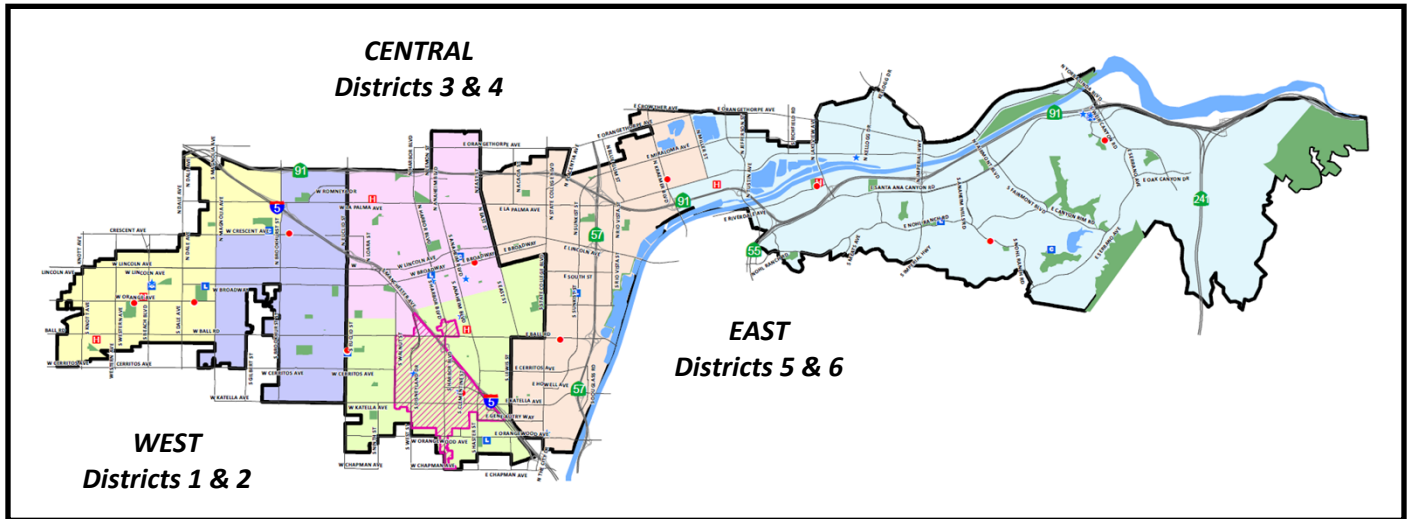


ANAHEIM NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (NIP)

Neighborhood Improvement Teams are comprised of staff representing the following departments:

- City Attorney
- Community & Economic Development
- Community Services
- Fire & Rescue
- Planning & Building
- Police
- Public Utilities
- Public Works

Additional departments provide support as needed.

With the implementation of Council Districts, the NIP and district teams, will transition to a structure that will continue to address neighborhood improvement while fostering positive relationships with internal and external stakeholders.

The strength of the NIP is its inter-departmental approach in assisting with neighborhood improvement. Working within the new city districts while representing virtually every department providing services to neighborhoods, this program has been identified as an important need within the community.

As we transition our team structure, we will also transition our Neighborhood Council Meetings to new District Community Meetings. These meetings will occur three times a year in each of the six districts. They will continue to provide opportunities for staff to share information on city projects, initiatives and/or updates while giving stakeholders the ability to connect with staff and find ways to get involved in the community, meet their neighbors and work together in keeping Anaheim a great place to live.
