

Brea Boulevard Bridge Maintenance Project



Project Summary

OC Public Works will remove and replace the guardrails at two bridge locations on Brea Boulevard in unincorporated Orange County. In an effort to reduce the impact on area motorists, all work activity will be performed at night outside of typical peak hours. Motorists traveling through the project area will experience slow moving traffic and lane closures during regular working hours.

WHAT

OC Public Works will remove and replace the existing guardrail systems at two bridge locations along Brea Boulevard. Construction activity will occur in unincorporated Orange County, adjacent to the City of Brea. For the safety of crews and contractors, the posted speed limit will be reduced to 45 MPH.

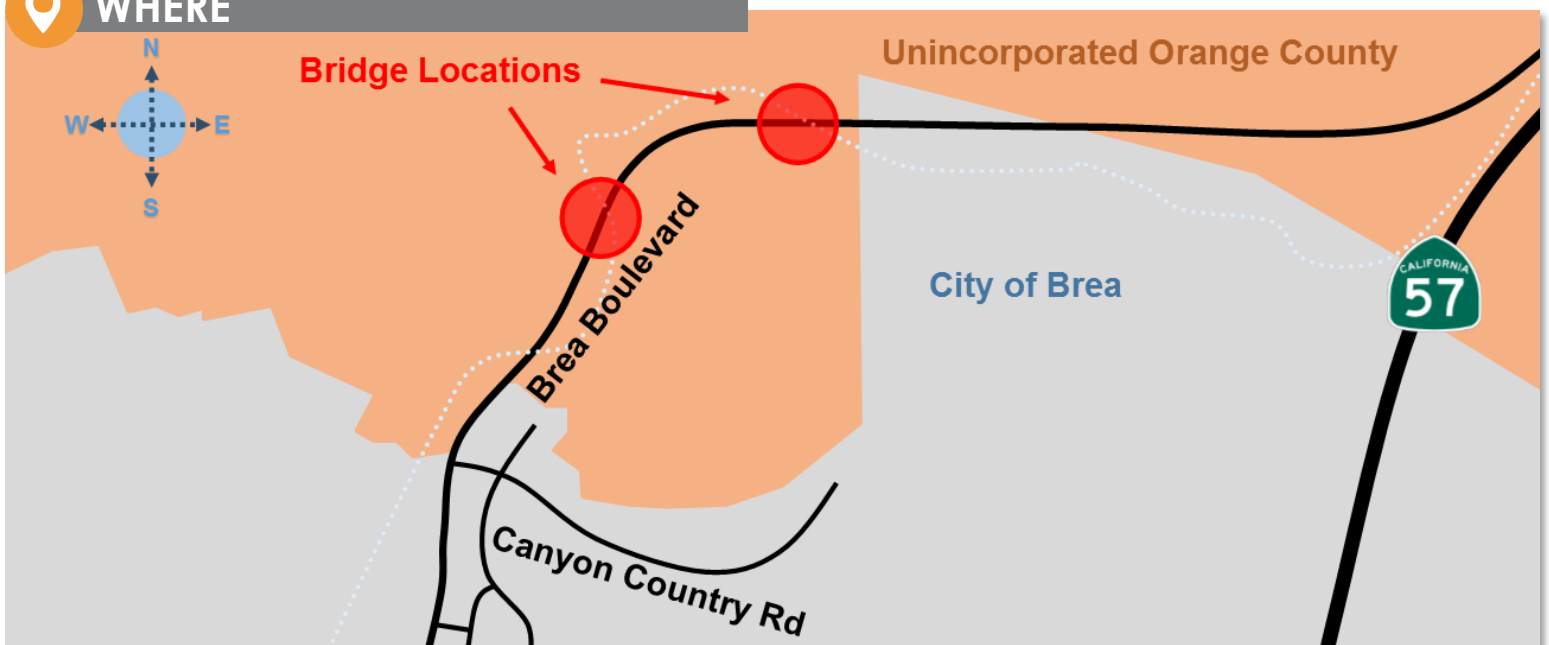
