1. Jason Hensley - OC Public Libraries

Jason is the Community Relations Assistant for OC Public Libraries and served as a point person for the 39+ library locations throughout the County resulting in the collection of 2,992 pounds of food.

A special acknowledgement for Janice Kollander from Heritage Park Library for expanding the drive at her location to include the public resulting in the collection of 500 pounds of food from the Heritage Park Library alone!

2. Stacy Dyer - Social Services Agency

Stacy was the point person for all SSA locations and included an article about the food drive in her agency newsletter resulting in the collection of 2,987 pounds of food from 18 sites.

3. Amber Alford and Sylvia Goldie - Health Care Agency

Amber and Sylvia work for the Health Care Agency's Human Resources/Volunteer Services Division and were the designated contacts for their agency. Amber and Goldie worked with several coordinators from 15+ locations resulting in the collection of 2,809 pounds of food.
