Subject: 91 Express Lanes Toll Update

The traffic volumes during seven hours in the eastbound direction have reached the trigger point for a toll decrease. Effective October 1, 2009, the toll rates will be adjusted for seven hours. Customers will be notified via in-lane variable message signs, customer newsletter, 91 Express Lanes website, and an e-mail broadcast. See Attachment A for the Toll Adjustment History Chart. The table below identifies the adjustment.

Wednesday	5 p.m. – 6 p.m.	\$8.25 to \$7.75
Wednesday	6 p.m. – 7 p.m.	\$4.10 to \$3.60
Friday	5 p.m. – 6 p.m.	\$7.75 to \$7.25

Toll rates will now vary depending on hour, day, and direction of travel from \$1.30 to \$9.90.
