

What is the CalOptima Regional Extension Center (COREC)?

The CalOptima Regional Extension Center (COREC) is a technical assistance center that will help eligible providers select, implement, and meaningfully use electronic health records (EHRs). COREC is funded by the Office of the National Coordinator, Department of Health and Human Services* to serve the providers in Orange County, California.

Who is Eligible for COREC services?

All Orange County health care providers are eligible for COREC services. COREC will initially focus on assisting primary care physicians, physician assistants, and nurse practitioners who operate in the following settings:

- Individual and small group practices (10 or fewer professionals with prescriptive privileges) – primarily focused on primary care;
- Community health centers and rural health clinics; and
- Other settings that predominantly serve uninsured, underinsured, and medically underserved populations.

Why Should You Participate?

Eligible providers can receive incentive payments from Medicare and Medicaid to implement and use EHR. COREC wants to help you obtain these funds.
