CAMP PENDLETON RECEIVES COMMANDER IN CHIEF'S ANNUAL AWARD FOR INSTALLATION EXCELLENCE

This marks the second time Camp Pendleton has received the award since its inception 22 years ago, with the first coming in fiscal year 2001.
