**CRITTER OF THE MONTH:** Fishing from the beach is a popular past time for many of our park



visitors, and the **spotted and yellow fin croakers** are two of the most caught fish along the Doheny shoreline. The best bait is clam, but they will also bite on ghost shrimp, fresh mussels, bloodworms and innkeeper worms. Best tackle is a high/low leader with number 6 or 4 hooks. The best time for fishing is late summer to fall. These critters will follow the tides, so fishermen should do the same. Fish two hours before and after a high tide, especially a late afternoon or evening tide. Late evening and night is the best time to catch a croaker. Remember, you need a valid CA fishing license!

HEY, TIDE POOL EXPLORERS! October brings us the first afternoon minus tides since last March: Oct. 7th (-0.5 @ 3:41 PM), 8<sup>th</sup> (-0.7 @ 4:28 PM), 9<sup>th</sup> (-0.7 @ 5:17 PM) and 10<sup>th</sup> (-0.4 @ 6:11 PM). Remember the Good Tide Pooler Rules: No collecting of animals or shells (Doheny is a Marine Protected Area); Do not pick up critters; Do not turn over rocks (you'll destroy a critter's home); If you absolutely must touch, do so lightly with two fingers.

**BATTLE OF THE PADDLE:** Saturday and Sunday, Oct. 2 & 3. Enjoy the evolutionary spirit of stand-up paddling with this 2-day autumn event. This contest is open to all levels of stand-up paddling; everything from beginners to children to a master's category.
