# DOHENY UPDATE for JUNE 2013



Who wouldn't be happy on a beautiful day off the Dana Point coastline. A gray whale heading north.

SUNRISE / SUNSET: On June 1<sup>st</sup>, we gain 53 seconds of sunlight from the day before. June 30<sup>th</sup>, we lose just 25 seconds from the previous day. The longest amount of daylight will on June 20<sup>th</sup>. June 1: Sunrise @ 5:43 AM / Sunset @ 7:59 PM = 14 hrs. 16 mins. 54 secs. of sun. June 20: Sunrise @5:42 AM / Sunset @ 8:08 PM = 14 hrs. 25 mins. 34 secs. of sun

June 20. Sum ise (a) 5.42 AM / Sunset (a) 8.08 PM = 14 hrs. 23 mins. 34 secs. of sum June 30: Sunrise (a) 5.45 AM / Sunset (a) 8.08 PM = 14 hrs. 23 mins. 24 secs. of sum
