Tall Ships Festival September 6-8, 2013

Boating

The Tall Ships Festival activities will begin with the Tall Ships Sunset Parade sail Friday from 4:30 PM to 7:30 PM. The Tall Ships Sunset Cannon Battle will take place Saturday and Sunday between 4:30 PM and 7:30 PM.

Boaters should remember that Tall Ships do not maneuver easily and that ship crews may not see smaller vessels as they close in. Therefore, boaters are advised to maintain a safe distance from Tall Ships at all times.

Please help make this a safe and fun event!

Sailing:

Spectator vessels should stay at least 300' from all Tall Ships, and should not cross ahead of, or between the vessels.

If a spectator vessel sails in between Tall Ships during cannon battles, the ships cannot fire.

Anchoring:

The Harbor Patrol and the Coast Guard Auxiliary will be maintaining a clear anchorage area in the West Harbor so the Tall Ships can safely travel to and from the Ocean Institute docks. Please do not anchor in the West Harbor near Ocean Institute during the Festival. Also, a traffic lane will be maintained in the outter channel for the vessels' safe transit.

If you are planning to anchor in the Harbor, please check with the Harbor Patrol ahead of time at (949) 248-2222.
