**DOHENY, 1928:** Pre-State Park days. The paved road is the Pacific Coast Highway. The entrance road in front of the old Dana Villa Hotel is now Dana Point Harbor Drive. In the background is the old Capistrano Beach pier; a beautiful 1,200 foot-long pier built in the late 1920s by Edward (Ned) Doheny Jr. and the Capistrano Beach Company. Due to lack of maintenance and years of surf, tides and storms, it was closed in the early 1950's and torn down in the early 1970's.
