<u>CRITTER OF THE MONTH</u>: Not a critter this month, but an important ecosystem just off the coast that helps sustain the life of our tide pool inhabitants (as well as the oxygen supply of the planet). The kelp ecosystem provides food and habitat for a variety of fish and other species. Known as the fastest growing alga, giant kelp can grow as much as 0.6m (2 feet) per day.
