GRANTS AND DONATIONS: DSBIA has been awarded another grant from Southern California Edison of \$7,500 to use towards its mission of interpretation of the natural and social stories of our wonderful park. Thank you, DSBIA member Kathy Oshima, who is our grant coordinator with So. Cal, Edison.

We have also received generous donations from **The Long Board Collectors Club** and **Dr. Udo Wahn**, author of the Cabo and Coral series of children's books.

DSBIA SUPPORTS RETAINING STATE PARK FUNDS: The Board of Directors of DSBIA has unanimously voted to support the California State Parks Foundation's letter urging the Legislature and Governor to allocate the recently-identified State Park and Recreation Fund (SPRF) revenues back into our state park system rather than taking the funds to fill other state programs.

ADD TO YOUR VOLUNTEER COLLECTION OF SKILLS: More and more events, including many of those sponsored or assisted by DSBIA, are including "Beer Gardens" or serving wine and spirits. DSBIA and the California Alcohol Beverage Control Board are requiring our volunteer servers at these events to have valid California Seller / Server Certification. Certification can be earned on-line in a 3-unit course from Learn2Serve. The course costs \$14.95 and takes about 4 hours to complete (it does not need to be completed in one sitting). The certification is good for 2 years. No, the course is not about mixing drinks, but about responsibly serving alcoholic beverages.
