

Bone Yard is the surf break closest to the jetty where rocks stick out of the water at middle and low tides. The name came decades before there was a jetty as it was an even rockier spot then, consuming the "bones" of unlucky surfboards and surfers. Bone Yard is a popular spot producing left and right






breaking waves on the outside, good for nose riding. It also has gentle inside waves perfect for very young surfers to learn the basics. The jetty is a fine spot for an audience to watch the surfers.

RED ROCKS AND FLOWING WATER IN SAN JUAN CREEK: The South Orange Coastal Ocean



Desalination Project is conducting testing in our park for a future drinking water supply by tapping into an aquifer under the ocean. The environmentally friendly technology is part of a pilot study for an ocean desalination project. The red coloration on the rocks along San Juan Creek is from iron that naturally occurs in the ground water and is harmless to humans and sea life. The current testing involves pumping water from under Doheny State Beach through a slant well to test the quality and treatability of water for drinking purposes. Concentrated ocean water (brine) from the full scale project will be blended and discharged two miles offshore through the San Juan Creek Ocean Outfall. the Doheny Longboard Surfing Association, have been elected to serve out the remainder of the two Board positions that were open. All board positions are up for election in January of each year.


