<u>CRITTER OF THE MONTH</u>: The Garibaldi is a beautiful fish that Doheny visitors may see



swimming along the breakwater or if out snorkeling in rock reefs or kelp forests. Their geographical range is the warm, rocky, near-shore shallow water of central and southern California, the Channel Islands and Baja California. They are members of the Damselfish family and are not related to gold fish. Garibaldi are solitary in nature and do not "school". The adult is about 12 to 14 inches in length and is fiercely territorial, often attacking larger animals that threaten its young.

Garibaldi life expectancy is 12 years, with some reaching the age of 17. The bright orange color may ward off

potential predators. In 1995, the garibaldi became the official California Marine Fish and is now protected from commercial and private aquarium collectors who were seriously depleting the stock. They
