4:21 PM), Nov.7 (-1.0 @ 4:08 PM), Nov. 8 (-1.0 @ 4:56 PM). Good (but not as good) low tides over Thanksgiving week, as well: the 21<sup>st</sup> (-0.6 @ 3:11 PM), 22<sup>nd</sup> (-0.7 @ 3:50), 23<sup>rd</sup> (-0.7 @ 4:33).
