## WHAT'S UP WITH THE VISITORS CENTER (VC): A lot of progress has been made on the outside and inside of the VC building

since the disaster that forced its closing in 2007. The interior of the building has been framed and much of it has been dry walled. Ranger Serpa has approved the mural and the process for its inclusion has begun. The electrical still needs to be done as well as some of the plumping. State park maintenance staff has completed much of the work. DSBIA has raised over \$30K that has gone or will go towards this project and our partners at Surfrider Foundation have made a significant contribution, as well. Mitigation money from the desalination plant test drilling that has been going on in the park for the past year and a half will pay for aquariums, tide pool, and life support systems. Depending on whom you talk to, the VC could be open this summer or early fall, but things go extremely slow when dealing with the State of California's rules and regulations.

GOOD TIDE POOL EXPLORING DATES IN DEC.: Good negative tides this month for tide pool explorers. Dec. 3 (-1.0 @ 1:51 PM), Dec. 4 (-1.2 @) 2:34 PM), Dec. 5 (-1.3 @ 3:16 PM), Dec. 6 (-1.2 @ 3:58 PM), Dec. 7 (-0.9 @ 4:39 PM), Dec. 19 (-0.8 @ 2:26 PM), Dec. 20 (-1.1 @ 3:02 PM), Dec. 21 (-1.2 @ 3:39 PM), Dec. 22 (-1.2 @ 4:18 PM), Dec. 23 (-1.1 @ 4:59 PM). Remember the Good Tide Pooler Rules: No collecting of animals or shells (Doheny is a Marine Protected Area); Do not pick up critters; Do not turn over rocks (you'll destroy a critter's home); If you absolutely must touch, do so lightly with two fingers.

**CRITTER OF THE MONTH:** The octopus is the most intelligent of all the invertebrates and can be



found from the inter-tidal areas along our coastline to depths as great as 15,000 feet. The octopus can teach itself many complex tasks and learn from watching other octopus.
