GOOD TIDE POOL EXPLORING DATES IN JAN.: Good negative tides this month for tide pool explorers. Jan. 1 (-1.0 @ 1:49 PM), Jan. 2 (-1.2 @) 2:29 PM), Jan. 3 (-1.2 @) 3:06 PM), Jan. 4 (-1.1 @ 3:41 PM), Jan. 17 (-1.0 @ 2:08 PM), Jan. 18 (-1.3 @ 2:42 PM), Jan. 19 (-1.5 @ 3:17 PM), Jan. 20 (-1.4 @ 3:52 PM), Jan. 21 (-1.1 @ 4:28 PM), Jan 30 (-0.9 @ 1:41 PM) PM, Jan 31 (-1.0 @ 2:17 PM). Remember the Good Tide Pooler Rules: No collecting of animals or shells (Doheny is a Marine Protected Area); Do not pick up critters; Do not turn over rocks (you'll destroy a critter's home); If you absolutely must touch, do so lightly with two fingers and respect.

DID YOU KNOW?: The highest and lowest tides of a month occur on the same day. Take January 19^{th} as an example. Highest tide of the month is + 6.7 feet (a) 8:09 AM and lowest tide of the month is at 3:17 PM @ -1.5 feet. That's an 8-foot change in the tide level.
