DUI ROVING PATROL EVENT

SANTA ANA, California (June 7, 2012) – The "Avoid the 12" DUI Task Force of the Orange County Sheriff's Department will be conducting DUI roving patrols in the cities of Lake Forest, Mission Viejo and Rancho Santa Margarita on Friday, June 8, 2012. These multi-city DUI teams will target areas that have a high incidence of DUI related arrests and collisions.

The goal of the program is to reduce the rate at which the citizens of Orange County are killed or injured in DUI related collisions. Through the implementation of these events, the Orange County Sheriff's Department hopes to significantly reduce deaths, injuries and property damage in each of our contract cities.

Orange County Sheriff's Department Deputies are committed to working hand-in-hand with their contract city partners in providing a safe environment for the motoring public.
