

SUNRISE / SUNSET: On March 1st, we gain 2 minutes, 5 seconds of sunlight from the day before. March 31, we gain 2 minute and 6 seconds from the previous day.

March 1: Sunrise @ 6:21 AM / Sunset @ 5:50PM = 11 hrs. 28 mins. 21 secs. of sun.

Daylight Savings Time begins on March 10. Spring forward one hour.

Vernal Equinox (Spring begins) March 20 @ 4:02 PM

March 31: Sunrise @ 6:41 AM / Sunset @ 7:13 PM = 12 hrs. 32 mins. 02 secs. of sun GAINED MINUTES OF DAYLIGHT: +20 AM minutes / +84 PM minutes Total: +104 minutes

WHY "DOHENY" STATE BEACH? Most of the land that now makes up Doheny State Beach was donated to the State of California by oil tycoon Edward Doheny, Sr. for the purpose of creating a public park in memorial of his adult son, Edward "Ned" Doheny, Jr. Ned died in his grandiose Beverly Hills mansion under mysterious circumstance on Feb. 17, 1929. The movie, "There Will Be Blood" ("I drink your milkshake!") is loosely based on the life of Doheny, Sr. He and Ned were caught up in the Teapot Dome scandal of the 1920's. Ned's death (a murder? a suicide?) seemed to be "swept under the rug" to protect the names of those involved and perhaps to derail a U.S. Senate investigation.
