## Fifth District 2012 Goals

### **Dana Point Harbor**

- Advance the Dana Point Harbor Revitalization Project through securing a contract to complete design for the Dana Point Harbor Revitalization Project's Commercial Core and prepare the Coastal Development Permit application for the project.
- And complete the Response to Comments for the Supplemental Environmental Impact Report for the Waterside portion of the Revitalization Plan.
- Promote water safety through education and outreach to the boating and Human Powered Craft community in Dana Point Harbor.
- Continue efforts to improve water quality in the Harbor through the annual Underwater Cleanup event and the use of underwater skimmers to collect debris and marine trash for proper disposal.

### **Health Care Agency**

- Increase education and outreach to reduce tobacco usage rates among youth in South County, where high school students have the highest rates of tobacco use in the County.
- Heighten awareness of the need for immunizations.

### **Libraries**

- Complete the Laguna Niguel Library Expansion in the spring.
- Assist in the development of a policy to install filters on all Orange County Public Libraries computers to protect children and other patrons from being exposed to offensive material.

### **Parks**

- Complete the property exchange with City of Mission Viejo to facilitate a City Dog Park project and secure County trail right-of-way.
- Obtain permit for Poche Beach channel outlet maintenance which is vital to improving ocean water quality.
- Complete repair and rehabilitation projects for South Laguna Beach stairways at Thousand Steps and Laguna Royale beaches.

- Develop a plan for addressing erosion issues at Wagon Wheel Creek.
- Finalize plans and funding for the Old AMWA (Aliso Maintenance Water Agency) Bridge Improvement project.

## **Roads**

- Complete design, permitting and preparation of construction documents to award a construction contract for the La Pata Avenue Gap Closure project.
- Complete construction of the Antonio Parkway widening project (from 4 to 6 lanes) from Ladera Ranch to Ortega Highway.
- Complete design and begin construction of Cow Camp Road between Antonio Parkway to the future FTC.
- Engage a coordinated effort between the County, TCA and Rancho Mission Viejo in the development and construction of the phased implementation of the 241 Extension (Tesoro Extension).

## **Social Services Agency**

- Work with the City of Laguna Beach to coordinate and ensure the provision of County services to the Laguna Beach homeless population that regularly utilizes shelter facilities.

In the Fifth District, we also have a number of exciting annual community events planned for 2012.

- Host the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual South County Children & Youth Summit
- Host the 5<sup>th</sup> annual South County Senior Summit.
- Host the 5<sup>th</sup> annual South County Disaster Preparedness Expo.
- Work with the Orange County Workforce Investment Board to co-host the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual South County Job Fair.
- Work with Orange County Rescue Mission to co-host a South County Summit on Homelessness.
