# AB 2175: Water conservation targets

	Urban	Agricultural
2000*	9 million acre-feet	34 million acre-feet
By 2009		Targets set by state
By 2012	5% reduction	Suppliers set targets

# AB 2013: Water permeable pavement

- Engineered pavement
  - Percolates 10" per day
  - Pervious concrete, permeable interlocking pavers, concrete grid pavers, porous asphalt
- Authorized on permits after 1/1/2012
- Cost savings compared to impervious pavement + stormwater control systems & filtration systems

# AB 2882: water conservation pricing

- Authorizes conservation pricing to discourage wasteful water use
  - Basic allocation
  - Conservation charge for overuse above allocation
  - Conservation charges fund education, devices, and retrofitting to achieve water conservation
