## OC Sheriff's Host Free Seminars for ABC Licensed Businesses

**SANTA ANA, California** (October 1, 2012) – The Orange County Sheriff's Department, in partnership with the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC), is hosting free seminars for ABC Licensees and their employees this month in Stanton and Laguna Niguel.

The LEAD (Licensee Education on Alcohol and Drugs) seminars educate businesses on laws involving the sale and service of alcoholic beverages. The curriculum is designed for licensees, managers, and employees. The LEAD program provides practical information on serving alcoholic beverages safely, responsibly, and legally, and preventing illicit drug activity at the licensed establishment.

"These seminars help businesses better understand their responsibilities," states Orange County Sheriff Sandra Hutchens. "It provides them with the tools and knowledge they need to promote reasonable consumption and contribute to making communities safer."
