Timeless Melodies now set for Sunday, March 4

Make plans for the Timeless Melodies program featuring the fabulous songs of the 20th century on Sunday, March 4.

The Timeless Melodies program, originally scheduled for Feb. 25, featuring music historian Larry Maurer is at 7 p.m. in the Mission Viejo Council Chamber at City Hall, 200 Civic Center.

The vivid program will highlight Rodgers & Hammerstein as you've never heard them before.
