- New this year, music and art under the stars. The tribute bands for the Platters and the Drifters will play Saturday evening while you enjoy art, artisan works and the California wine and beer garden.
- As part of the festival's 1950s theme, try your hand at paint by numbers, get a photo with Elvis, see an overview of the music of the 1950s and don't forget to Hula Hoop.
- Demonstration gardens will be on display to help you create a vertical wall garden, "Moon" garden and enliven your small space.
- Sustainable art made from recycled materials will also be on display, including art created by teens.
- Children and teen design winners for new Mission Viejo Library cards will be presented by Bob Singer.
- No need to pack a lunch or dinner, as food trucks and vendors will be on hand with an array of tasty fare.

The fun-filled festival is from 12 p.m. to 8 p.m. Saturday, May 5 and from 12 p.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday, May 6 at Oso Viejo Park and the Norman P. Murray Community and Senior Center, 24932 Veterans Way.
