Vaccination Clinic Opens Early on March 6 Low Cost Pet Vaccination Clinic Opens 30 Minutes Early for Cats Only

(2/25/2013) Rancho Santa Margarita, CA – On the first Wednesday of every month the City of Rancho Santa Margarita hosts a low cost pet vaccination clinic at the Bell Tower Regional Community Center from 7:00-8:30 p.m. Beginning March 6, the vaccination clinic will open early for cats only at 6:30 p.m. This is to alleviate stress on our feline friends. No appointment is needed; pets are treated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Dogs must be on leashes and cats must be in carriers. Owners 18 year of age or older must accompany their pets.
