

#### FEMA GRADING CRITERIA: 6 KEY AREAS

#### **AREA 1: EMERGENCY OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT**

Alert, notify and mobilize emergency personnel in a timely manner; maintain adequate facilities, maps, equipment, etc.

#### **AREA 2: PROTECTIVE ACTION DECISION-MAKING**

Utilization of decision making process; recommendations and decisions are made using accurate field monitoring data (includes the recommendation for the use of KI)

#### **AREA 3: PROTECTIVE ACTION IMPLEMENTATION**

Use of appropriate dosimetry equipment and procedures; manage exposure to emergency workers; include special needs populations and schools in decision making; implementation of traffic access and control procedures

#### FEMA GRADING CRITERIA CONTINUED

#### **AREA 4: FIELD MEASUREMENT AND ANALYSIS**

Ensure field teams are adequately equipped and can manage radiation sample collection and measurement; support protective action decisions with accurate data

#### **AREA 5: EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION & PUBLIC INFORMATION**

Alert and notification to the public is done in a timely manner; information and instructions are accurate
