

NEGATIVE IMPACT

- Undermining County law enforcement officials.
- Adding a widespread layer of unnecessary bureaucracy.
- Increasing County liability.

Redundant process that is inconsistent with the Orange County model of lean government and direct accountability.

LIABILITY COMPARISON 10-YEAR PERIOD

- 26 million = total County payouts
- 7.2 million = Sheriff's Department
 - \blacksquare 1.5 million = jail litigation
- Only 27% of the county payouts was for the Sheriff's Department.
