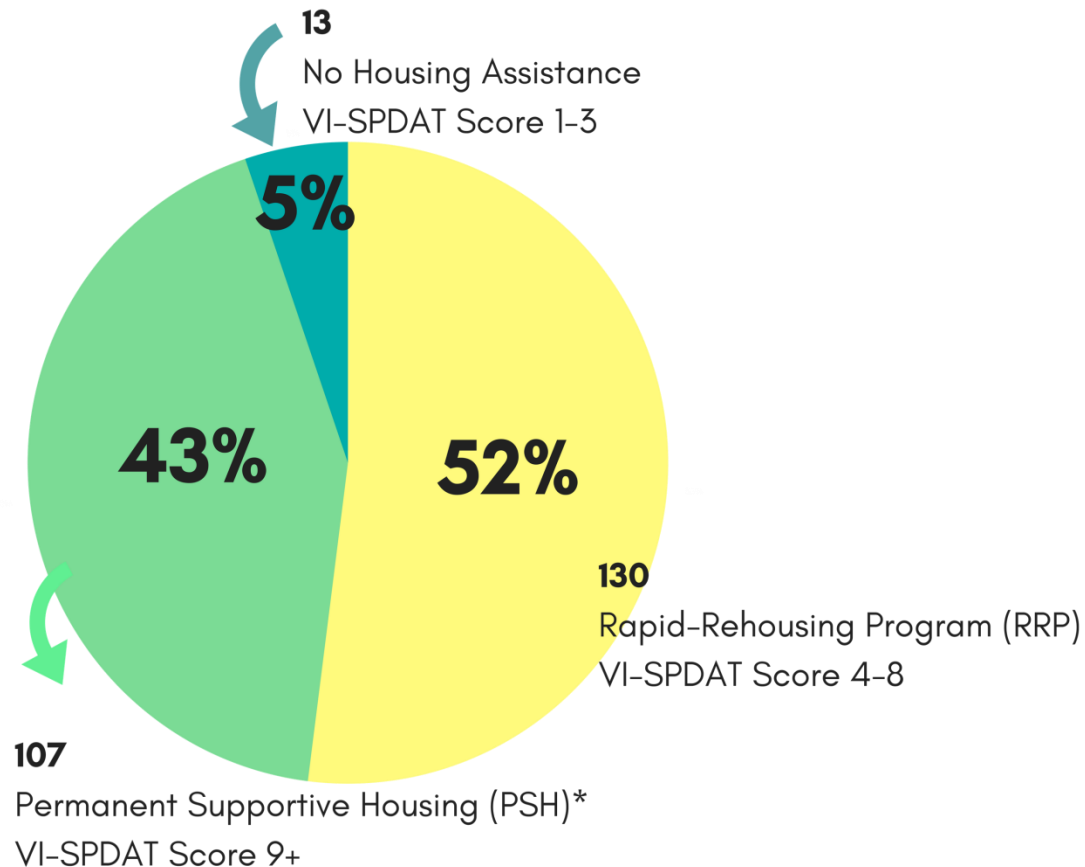

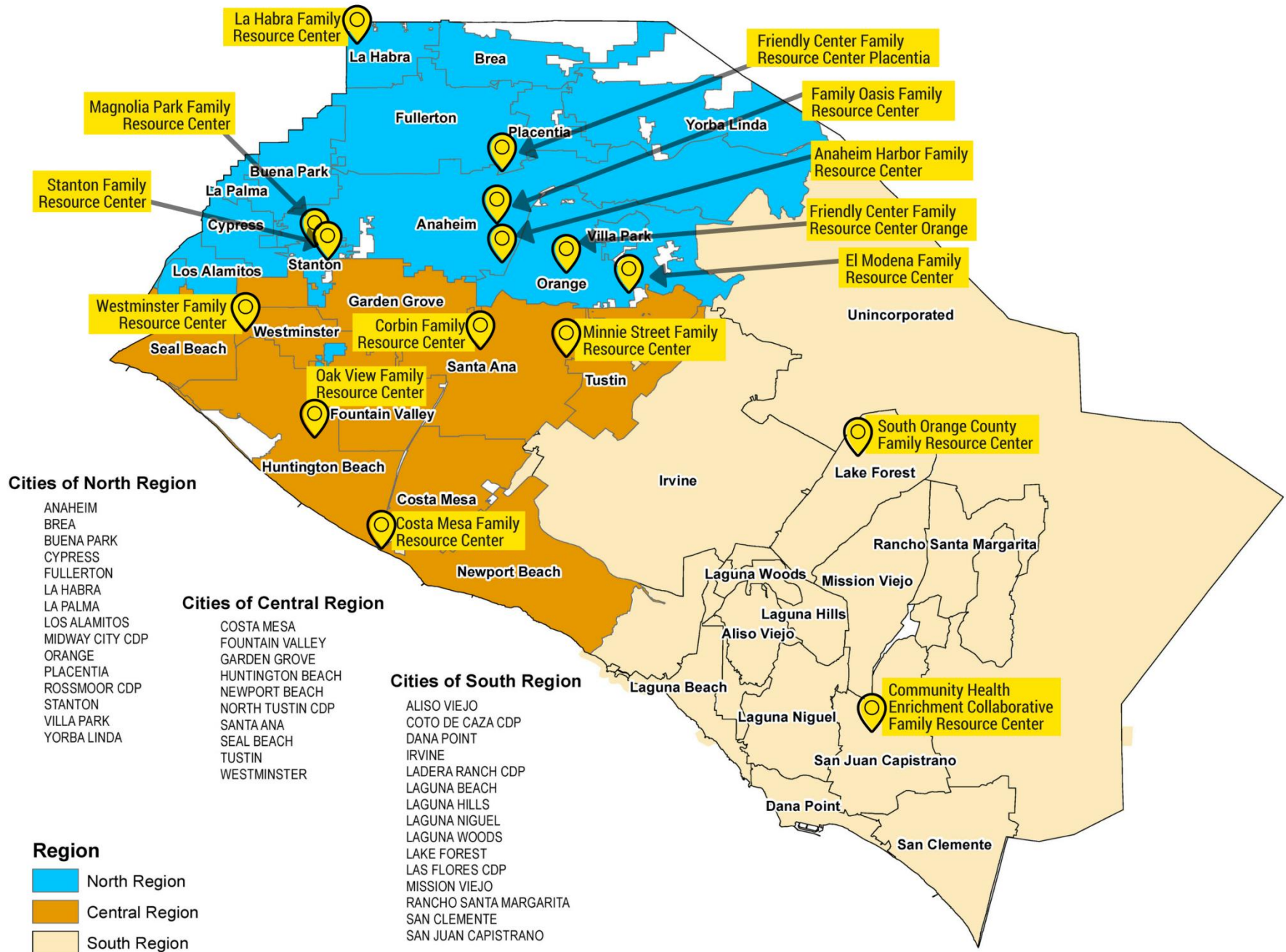

Streamline family access and navigation of system

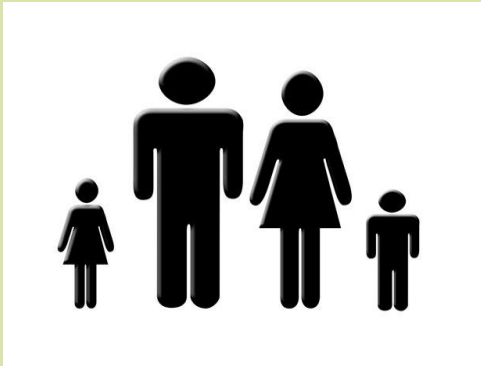
Increase coordination of shelter beds and CE System to create flow through the emergency system
