

Seven (7) PRC designated hospitals have been further designated as Base Hospitals. These hospitals will be required to continue ensuring the quality of paramedic care and providing education for paramedics. The County provides six of the Base Hospitals with radio equipment designed to provide direct communication between paramedics and the nurses and physicians providing medical orders for 9-1-1 patients. One facility (Anaheim Memorial Medical Center) is a modified Base Hospital performing quality assurance and education, but not direct radio contact. HCA and Anaheim Memorial are now in discussions with the intent of providing an 800 MHz Radio System for them to perform as a full Base Hospital. The 9-1-1 equipment remains the property of, and is maintained by, the County.

PARAMEDIC TRAUMA RECEIVING CENTERS

Three (3) of the hospitals have been designated as Paramedic Trauma Receiving Centers (PTRC). These hospitals accept and treat the most seriously injured trauma patients. The proposed agreement provides a formal PTRC designation and requires them to continue meeting the criteria for Trauma Center designation.
